

CHRISTMAS FLOWER CORNER Poinsettia



Poinsettias are commonly associated with the holiday season, particularly in Christmas decorations. They are known for their festive red and green foliage, although they come in various colors, including white, pink, and marble. Native to Mexico, these plants were named after Joel Poinsett, an American diplomat and botanist who introduced them to the United States in the early 1800s after discovering them there.

Poinsettias thrive in warm environments and require careful watering, as they are sensitive to overwatering. They're often used in arrangements and as potted plants during the festive season, symbolizing goodwill and celebration.



